- ♠ Players will start with 15,000 in tournament chips. Each level is 20 minutes.
- ♠ Progressive Bounty format. All players begin the tournament with a \$40 bounty. When a player is eliminated, half of the eliminated player's bounty is awarded to the eliminator and the other half is added to the eliminator's bounty. All bounties will be distributed in \$5 increments. When rounding is needed, paying bounty to the player (eliminator) will be the priority and adding to the progressive bounty will be secondary. When an all-in player is eliminated by 2 or more players, those players will chop the bounty and any \$5 increments that can not be chopped will be awarded in order of action.
- ♠ Registration will remain open until the start of level 7, during which players may enter or reenter an unlimited number of times at the registration counter. All original fees apply. Players must have zero (0) chips remaining to re-enter. Due to the bounty format, players may not forfeit or surrender their chips to re-enter.
- ♠ This tournament utilizes a big blind ante. If the big blind has less than the total obligation; the big blind is paid first, then the ante.
- ♠ This tournament is scheduled as a one-day tournament. The tournament director in their sole and absolute discretion may adjust the break schedule, adjust the start and stop time, adjust the level lengths, and/or add an additional day if necessary.
- ♠ There will be a 15-minute break approximately every 2 hours of play.
- ♠ \$180 buy-in = \$140 prize pool (\$40 distributed as a bounty, \$100 distributed as the posted prize pool), + \$40 administrative fee A 4% staff gratuity will be deducted from the posted prize pool.
- ♠ Prizes will be awarded to approximately the top ten percent of the field. Winners must show valid identification to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding. Pursuant to IRS regulations, W-2G or 1042 forms will be issued for all tournament winnings of \$5,000 or more (net of one buy-in).
- ♠ Color of chip denominations: Black=100, Blue=500, Orange=1,000, Red=5,000, Yellow=25,000, Pink=100,000.
- ♠ By participating in this tournament, players hereby give their consent to the Palm Beach Kennel Club and its affiliates to use their name and likeness on social media, internet sites, email, and for any and all commercial purposes.
